## WHAT

**Garrett's Space, a suicide prevention nonprofit, is excited to announce our fourth annual fundraiser, Go4Garrett'sSpace.** This year's event, held in person for the first time, will again share an incredible lineup of musical performers, poets, classes taught by leading fitness, meditation, and yoga instructors, and inspirational speakers who have been touched by depression and suicide. Our goal is to bring together 200+ community members who are committed to providing hope and healing for young adults struggling with depression and anxiety. We will also live stream the event for those who can't attend in person.

## WHY

The mental health crisis is real in our community. Today, suicide is the second leading cause of death for young people ages 15-24 in the state of Michigan; and in Washtenaw County, mental health crisis calls involving young people are up 20% year over year, with the mobile crisis team responding mostly to young adults ages 20-30. In addition to riveting entertainment and rejuvenating activities, the fundraiser will spotlight the suicide crisis impacting our young people and highlight our mission and vision. The event will raise critical funding to support our wellness programming and the creation of our holistically-focused residential center which will serve as a model to be replicated across the country. **We invite you to partner with us by sponsoring this special event.**
