WHAT

Garrett's Space, a suicide prevention nonprofit, is excited to announce our fifth annual fundraiser, Go4GarrettsSpace. This year's event will bring together 250+ community members who are committed to providing hope and healing for young adults struggling with depression and anxiety. Guests will enjoy a light dinner, silent auction featuring many local businesses and artists, and a compelling program featuring testimonials from young adults with lived experience of depression and anxiety, an update on our envisioned non-medical, holistically focused residential center from co-founders Juile and Scott Halpert, and the second annual "Spirit of Garrett" award ceremony.

WHY

The mental health crisis is real in our community. Today, suicide is the second leading cause of death for young people ages 15-24 in Michigan and young adults are struggling in staggering numbers with depression and anxiety. In a recent survey 70% of young adults ages 18-24 reported being moderately or severely depressed, while another survey reported less than half of young adults with mental illness received treatment in 2021. The Garrett's Space model is designed to fill the huge gap in support options and change the quality of life for young adults in Michigan and this event will raise critical funds to support our wellness programming and the creation of our residential center.
